## **SAMPLE ITINERARY** (Subject to change)

**DAY 1 & 2: USA—ROME (WD).** Arrive in Rome. Brief orientation tour. Lunch on your own. Check-in to hotel. Free time. Welcome group dinner.

**DAY 3: ROME (B, D).** Breakfast. Sightseeing tour of the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel, St. Peter's Square and St. Peter's Basilica OR a half day tour of Rome including a visit to the Colosseum and the Roman Forum. Lunch on your own. **CONCERT I.** Group dinner.

**DAY 4: ROME – POMPEII – NAPLES (B, L).** Breakfast . Depart for Pompeii. Enjoy a guided tour of Italy's most famous archaeological site with an excavated area of almost 109 acres. No other ancient town has been brought to light so completely. Lunch on your own. Continue to Naples. Group dinner.

**DAY 5: NAPLES (B, D).** Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Naples. Visit the National Archeological Museum. The oldest of its kind in Europe, this museum houses the most impressive artifacts from Pompeii and Herculaneum. Lunch on your own. **CONCERT II.** Group dinner.

**DAY 6: NAPLES – MATERA – BARI – OVERNIGHT CRUISE (B, D).** Breakfast . Depart for Bari. En route to Bari, enjoy a stop in Matera if time permits. Located in the remote southern


region of Basilicata, it is a town famous for its extensive cave-dwelling districts, the sassi. **CONCERT III.** This concert may take place elsewhere depending on timing. Lunch on your own. Overnight cruise to Patras. Group dinner.

**DAY 7: PATRAS – DELPHI (B, D).** Breakfast on the cruise. Arrive in Patras late morning to mid day. Lunch on your own. Depart for Delphi. Free time. Group dinner.

**DAY 8: DELPHI – ATHENS (B, D).** Breakfast . Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Delphi, home of the ancient Oracle and known in mythology as the "Navel of the Earth." Lunch on your own. Possible informal short concert at the ancient small Theatre of Delphi with a spectacular view. In the late afternoon, depart for Athens. Free time. Group dinner.

**DAY 9: ATHENS (B, D).** Breakfast . Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Athens. You can't help but walk around the Parthenon and the rest of the Acropolis and dream about the great ones who have come before you and whose footsteps you're in. Lunch on your own. **CONCERT IV.** Group dinner.

**DAY 10: ATHENS – USA (B).** Breakfast. Check out of the hotel. Depart for airport and board flight home! Arrive home.

*The following items are included in the package price.*

- Round trip airfare to/from Lexington, Cincinnati or Louisville to Rome with a return from Athens. We included a budget of \$1,400.00 per person which is subject to change based on final airfare costs. While the net base fare is often guaranteed, the government and carrier imposed passenger facility charges, security and custom charges, immigration charges, domestic and/or international taxes, federal excise taxes, fees, surcharges, levies, and any other charges are not guaranteed and are subject to increase. The Organization is responsible any increases in airfare costs.
- Seven (7) nights of twin or double, and partly triple room accommodations, including all taxes and service charges, at 3 star hotels, based on the final itinerary
- City taxes which are charged per night per person. Included is the budget \$21.00 USD total per person in city taxes based on a 3 star hotels. City taxes are subject to increase. Each tax will be paid to the hotel directly upon check-out and is subject to change.
- One (1) Overnight ferry from Italy to Greece.
- Eight (8) breakfasts at the hotels/ferry.
- One (1) welcome dinner.
- One (1) farewell dinner.
- Six (6) other meals, lunches or dinners, as per the final itinerary.
- One (1) Classical Movements tour manager from arrival to Rome and departure from Athens

The following items are **not** included in the package price.
